Vineyard characteristics:

Plot size: 11 hectares.

Fermentation takes place in new fine grain American and French oak casks. Aging for 24 months in the barrels with its lees that are stirred periodically (battonage). The barrels spend two winters outside the winery in the open air.

A further 24 months maturing in the bottle before being released.
